- ESCO is scheduling the labor to install the new 3<sup>rd</sup> Street substation.
- Cummins performed the annual maintenance and changed the oil in the generator.
- Shermco will clean and test the genbreaker on 3/15/2024.
- Treasurer McClelland motioned to adjourn at 6:24 pm, Secretary Manternach seconds, three ayes and the motion to adjourn carried.
